

Options for Covering Unexpected Overdrafts

Dear Member,

Life happens! Everyone's Federal Credit Union understands that unexpected overdrafts occur from time to time – Overdraft Coverage can help.

Overdraft Coverage Options

The choice is yours. Consider these ways to cover overdrafts:

| Service | Cost |

Overdraft Protection services apply to all transactions and may help prevent overdrafts by automatically transferring funds to your checking account from another account you may have at Everyone's Federal Credit Union for a fee.

Overdraft Privilege allows you to overdraw your account up to the disclosed limit for a fee in order to pay a transaction. Even if you have overdraft protection, Overdraft Privilege is still available as secondary coverage if the other protection source is exhausted. What Else You Should Know

- A link to another account may be a less expensive option than an overdraft. A single larger overdraft will result in just one fee, as opposed to multiple smaller overdrafts. Good account management is the best way to avoid overdrafts. Use our mobile banking, Internet banking, and telephone banking services to keep track of your balance. - The \$28 Overdraft Fee is the same fee amount that is charged if a check is returned as unpaid. If
 multiple items overdraw your account on the same day, each item will be assessed an
 appropriate Overdraft Fee or a NSF Fee of \$28. All fees and charges will be included as part of
 the Overdraft Privilege limit amount. Your account may become overdrawn more than the
 Overdraft Privilege limit amount because of a fee.
- For consumer accounts, there is <u>no limit</u> on the total Overdraft Fees per day we will charge. These exceptions do not apply to business accounts.
- This describes the posting order for purposes of determining overdrafts. We generally post items in the following order: 1) credits, 2) ATM and debit card transactions are paid in real time (in the order received), 3) ACH debits (low to high by dollar amount, 4) checks (check number order). However, because of the many ways we allow you to access your account, the posting order of individual items may differ from these general policies. Holds on funds (described below) and the order in which transactions are posted may impact the total amount of Overdraft Fees or NSF Fees assessed.
- Although under payment system rules, Everyone's Federal Credit Union may be obligated to pay some unauthorized debit card transactions, Everyone's Federal Credit Union will not authorize debit card or ATM transactions unless there are available funds (including Overdraft Coverage Options) to cover the transactions and any fee(s).
- Giving us your consent to pay every day debit card and ATM overdrafts on your consumer
 account may result in you incurring Overdraft Fees for transactions that we would otherwise be
 required to pay without assessing an Overdraft Fee. However, this would allow us to authorize
 transactions up to the amount of your Overdraft Privilege limit and may also help you avoid
 overdrafts in excess of your available balance that could result in suspension of your debit card.
- Everyone's Federal Credit Union authorizes and pays transactions using the available balance in your account. Everyone's Federal Credit Union may place a hold on deposited funds in accordance with our Deposit Account Agreement and Disclosure, which will reduce the amount in your available balance. The available balance for checks, ACH items, and recurring debit card transactions is comprised of the ledger balance, less any holds on deposited funds and any debit card holds, plus the amount of the Overdraft Privilege limit and any available overdraft protection. The available balance for ATM and everyday debit card transactions on accounts with Standard Coverage is the ledger balance, less any holds on deposited funds and any debit card holds, plus any available overdraft protection, but does NOT include the Overdraft Privilege Limit. For accounts with Extended Coverage, the Overdraft Privilege Limit is included in the available balance for authorizing ATM and everyday debit card transactions.
- Please be aware that the Overdraft Privilege amount is not included in your available balance provided through online banking, mobile banking or Everyone's Federal Credit Union's ATMs.
- Everyone's Federal Credit Union will place a hold on your account for any authorized debit card transaction until the transaction settles (usually within two business days) or as permitted by payment system rules. In some cases, the hold may exceed the amount of the transaction. When the hold ends, the funds will be added to the available balance in your account. If your

- account is overdrawn after the held funds are added to the available balance and the transaction is posted to the available balance, an Overdraft Fee may be assessed.
- Except as described in this letter, Everyone's Federal Credit Union will not pay items if your account does not contain available funds (including the Overdraft Privilege limit) to cover the item(s) and the amount of any fee(s).
- Everyone's Federal Credit Union may suspend your debit card if you incur overdrafts in excess of the available balance in your account, including any Overdraft Privilege limit (as described in this letter). Debit cards on your account will remain suspended until you make sufficient deposits so that your available balance, taking into account any Overdraft Privilege limit, is positive and then you contact us.
- Everyone's Federal Credit Union may also suspend your debit card if your account is overdrawn more than thirty-two (32) consecutive calendar days. Debit cards on your account will remain suspended until you make sufficient deposits so that your account balance is positive.
- Everyone's Federal Credit Union may also suspend your debit card if we are unable to contact you due to an incorrect mailing address or phone number(s). You must contact us with your correct mailing address and/or phone number(s) to have your debit card reinstated.
- If your debit card is suspended, you will be unable to use your debit card for purchases or to access your account at the ATM, and if you use your debit card for recurring payments, e.g., utilities, you are responsible to make other arrangements for your recurring debit payment(s).
- Overdraft Privilege is not a line of credit; it is a discretionary overdraft service that can be withdrawn at any time without prior notice.
- Overdraft Privilege may be discontinued if you default on any loan or other obligation to us, your account becomes subject to any legal or administrative order or levy, or if you fail to maintain your account in good standing by not bringing your account to a positive balance within thirty-two (32) days for a minimum of one business day. You must bring your account balance positive for at least one business day to have Overdraft Privilege reinstated.
- Depositor and each Authorized Signatory will continue to be liable, jointly and severally, for all overdraft and fee amounts, as described in the Deposit Account Agreement and Disclosure. The total (negative) balance, including all fees and charges, is due and payable upon demand.

Court Watson CEO Everyone's Federal Credit Union An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

- 1. We have standard overdraft practices that comes with your account.
- 2. We also offer overdraft protection plans. To learn more, ask us about these plans.

This notice explains our standard overdraft practices.

What are the standard overdraft practices that come with my account?

We <u>do</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We <u>will not</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions without your consent.

- ATM transactions
- Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction. If we do <u>not</u> authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

What fees will I be charged if Everyone's Federal Credit Union pays my overdraft? Under our standard overdraft practices:

- We will charge you a fee of up to \$28.00 each time we pay an overdraft
- There is <u>no limit</u> per day on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing your account

What if I want Everyone's Federal Credit Union to authorize and pay overdrafts on my ATM and everyday debit card transactions (Extended Coverage)?

If you want us to authorize and pay overdrafts for which an Overdraft fee will be assessed on ATM and everyday debit card transactions, call (575) 461-0433 press 2 or 3, visit our website at http://www.everyonesfcu.com, complete the form below and present it at a branch or mail it to: PO Box 1023, Tucumcari, NM 88401. You can revoke your authorization for Everyone's Federal Credit Union to pay these overdrafts at any time by any of the above methods. Your revocation must include both your name and your account number so that we can properly identify your account.
